

**Federal Loan Forgiveness - Qualifying PSD Schools**

<b>School</b>	<b>Low Income Status Year</b>
Evergreen	1998-99 to 2015-16
Harbor Heights	2012-13
Henderson Bay	1998-1999, to 2011-12, and 2014-15, 2015-16
Key Peninsula	1999-2000 to 2015-16
Minter	2003-2004 to 2015-16
Vaughn	1998-1999 to 2015-16

**NOTES:**

- 1) The 2016-17 school year is not reported yet in the system.
- 2) You should do the search with the name of the **school** and the **district** in BOTH School or Educational Service Agency Name AND Location. **TRY all combinations!**
- 3) You can go back and search former schools and district across the United States BUT you will need that employer to sign & verify service.
- 4) You can compile consecutive years from multiple schools / districts.
- 5) If you taught at a school in a year when it was first reported as a low income school BUT they fall off the next year, you can STILL count all subsequent years of consecutive years teaching as long as you remained at that school.
- 6) You can file an application for \$5000 of loan forgiveness every 5 consecutive years up to \$17,500.
- 7) SPED, Science and Math teachers are eligible for \$17,500 in loan forgiveness after the first 5 consecutive years.
